



MISSING LIFEBOUY PUTS LIVES AT RISK

Ludlow Town Council would like to enlist the help of residents to tackle a serious, but preventable issue – vandalism of lifebuoys on the river Teme. Just imagine how you might feel if you saw someone in distress in fast flowing River Teme and when you ran to the lifebuoy - it wasn't there!

What if you had to helplessly watch someone – maybe a member of your family - drowning, and if you tried to help, your own life could be in danger – a horrible situation that should be wished on nobody.

However, these haunting thoughts could be made real by this pointless vandalism. Thoughtless actions could cost someone their life – and this potential tragedy is totally avoidable.

The Town Council, initially with the aid of funds from Shropshire Council, provides lifebuoys along the Teme and has funded replacement lifebuoys to deal with the problems caused by vandalism, but considers these unnecessary costs a waste of resources.
