

LINNEY RIVERSIDE PARK CONSULTATION

Ludlow Town Council would like to thank everyone who filled in the Linney Riverside questionnaire – and reserve special thanks for the children of Ludlow School, Ludlow Junior School, St Laurence's School, and 'Busy Bodies' Nursery - who enthusiastically gave their expert opinions on play equipment.

The children's preference for the Wicksteed scheme (pictured) formed the basis for our Playbuilder grant application, which if successful will secure this part of the project. We now expect to hear whether or not the application has been successful in mid June, so although it may appear that progress is slow, nothing

can happen on site until we know the funds are in place. One clear preference has emerged from the initial analysis of the resident's feedback –residents share Ludlow Town Maintenance, the Environment Agency Development and Control team, and contractors to achieve our goals and protect our investment in recreational facilities whilst maintaining the area's capacity and important function as a flood plain.
