The gentleman, a resident of Ludlow, spoke on two issues:

Parking: He raised the issue that parking was a problem effecting Ludlow in economic terms because visitors were discouraged from shopping in the town. He described a system previously operated by SSDC and the Chamber at Smithfield carpark, which encouraged those making a short visit to redeemed tickets with SSDC and funds were donated to charity. He suggested Town Council could take positive action and consider a scheme that would refund parking costs for those making a visit of less than an hour. He handed the chairman some papers.

Town Benchmarking: The member of the public stated he had attended a meeting in May where he raised the issue of bench marking, and had subsequently spoken with the Town Clerk, but as yet had received no formal opinion on the matter from Ludlow Town Council. He handed the chairman a copy of an LJC funding application.

 - (b) Parking in Ludlow Members discussed issues including:
 - Problems caused by new parking meters in Corve Street and the Linney
 - Underwriting short stay free parking in Ludlow which could be funded by Town
 Development Fund, if monies are not already allocated elsewhere. However, it was
 also said that in reality up to one hour's free parking is not enough, and the
 underlying problem and major deterrent to shoppers in Ludlow is the lack of parking not the cost of parking.

Members **RESOLVED** that the Shropshire Council should be informed that the new black parking meters at the Linney needed to be made more visible with, for example, reflective panels to avoid accidents in the relatively poor lighting conditions

Members **RESOLVED** not to enter into further debate on parking in Ludlow before Shropshire Council's proposed review. Members also **AGREED** that Shropshire Council's review should be managed in a way that allowed plenty of time for considered debate and feedback on all the issues.
