Western Power are in negotiations with land owners to enable the cable to be laid underground along land off the A49 bypass to prevent disruption to roads and traffic. This land is potential development land and the negotiations are ongoing. The work is proposed to start in May 2014.

That Western Power report back to Members regarding the decisions of landowners adjoining the A49 along the proposed route.

Members strongly suggested that Western Power propose to the land owners that the cable be buried deeper than foundation level (2m) to avoid the land being devalued as potential development land.

Members asked that no works should take place at a time when disruption would be caused to festivals and the park and ride.

That Western Power fully explore the least disruptive routes and methods and avoid road closures in favour of re-routing and traffic control where possible.

Members requested that Fisher German LLP continue to liaise with the Friends of Whitcliffe Common and Shropshire Wildlife Trust as necessary during the proposed works and that fencing is removed once the works are completed.
