Comments from Peter Norman: This tree was the subject of correspondence between us on 8th and 11th September. My comments following a visit on 10th September still apply:

I looked at the tree with the owner today. No immediate danger and it is not the Town Wall but a neighbour's wall which would be affected if it failed. I advised him to go ahead with a Conservation Area notification. I don't believe the tree (Lawson's Cypress variety in a secluded back garden) will warrant a TPO.

No objection: members agreed to the comments received from Peter Norman, Ludlow Town Council's Tree Officer and stated no comment and requested that the tree could be left in a suitable place on Whitcliffe to provide dead wood habitat and that this suggestion be sent to Peter Norman and a letter sent to Friends of Whitcliffe.

Comments from Peter Norman: The removal of dead wood from public areas is good arboricultural practice and should not be opposed. The dead oak adjacent to the carpark is one of several that I have been monitoring over recent years and appears to be suffering a form of acute die-back. It is not likely to recover and, although it could be kept for a dead wood habitat, its location adjacent to the carpark represents a significant risk to public safety. Although the tree is clearly of public amenity value I do not believe that it warrants a TPO on grounds of expediency.
