R/154 PUBLIC OPEN SESSION (15 minutes)

There was two members of the public present

Mr T Cammish Foldgate View Ludlow

Mr Cammish is a resident of Foldgate View which is adjacent to the proposed development. He pointed out reasons to oppose the outline planning application.

- The potential to cause more flooding to areas around the development
- Issues in the past with inadequate sewage provision
- Access from the A49 with a T-Junction on a busy stretch of road.
- The area is a haven for wildlife and a local recreational area providing public footpaths.

He also refuted the developers statement that the development would be sustainable .

Mr G Perks Honey Meadow Ludlow

Mr Perks echoed Mr Cammishs points and urged members to assist Ludford Parish Council with robust objections to Foldgate Lane Planning application.

R/156 LUDLOW'S UNITARY COUNCILLORS QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

CIIr Parry, Ludlow South

Foldgate Lane Development 14/04608/OUT

Cllr Parry supported Mr Cammish's concerns and that of other residents objections to the development on Foldgate Lane. Flooding in the Steventon New Road area has been an issue in the past she felt this was made worse by the development around the area of Harry Tuffins. There are more suitable areas around the town for housing and the Foldgate Lane site is outside of the SAMDev boundary. Councillor Parry urged members to support Ludford Parish Council in opposing the outline Planning Application.

Temeside - slabbed area (item 12 c)

Councillor Parry informed members that the two areas at the bottom of Old Street which are currently slabbed with flower beds in the centre are being used as a parking area and this could be prevented by installing bollards and tarmacing the area. Permits could be obtained from Shropshire Council for South Shropshire Housing works vehicles. She requested that members invited the Environmental Agency to visit the area to assess the effect that small islands along the River Teme are being adopted by residents as gardens and this is having an effect on the flooding issues in the area.

Clir Andy Boddington, Ludlow North

Cllr Boddington informed members that SAMDevs in the public enquiry on November 20th 2014 all plans will be looked at in the Ludlow area. He explained that it is becoming increasingly difficult to object to applications objections now have to be specified in detail. There has been pressure to approve applications.

Representational Committee members rely on material planning considerations where as Shropshire Council as the local planning authority can refuse an application based on legislation and their policies.

Cllr Boddington said he was happy to advise residents of the policies and the impact on the environment and conservation in the area. He offered to provide members with sucsynched guidance on Shropshire Council's planning policies.

Several members and the Town Clerk attended the public meeting on the proposed development.

The Chair stated that Shropshire Council commented that:

- 1. Flood Forum no. 636 Surface water flooding, land adjacent to Greenacres
- 2. Flood Forum No.562: Flooding from culverts affects highways.
- 3. Flood forum No.1397: Possible obstruction of watercourse, potential flooding issues.

LTC would submit comments on the application even though the site is within Ludford Parish as access to the site is within Ludlow Town Council boundary. The site will also have an impact on the surrounding area, residents and local services.

Cllr Draper informed members that there had been serious issues with flooding of properties on Sheet Road following the recent developments at the top of Foldgate Lane which has caused drainage and sewage issues. There would also be an increase in road traffic

Members asked the Town Clerk to convey their concerns to Ludford Parish Council.

- Detrimental impact on the surrounding residents, and neighbouring roads.
- The high risk of further flooding on Steventon New road and Temeside.
- Drainage on surrounding areas
- Impact on traffic on Foldgate Lane, Harry Tuffins area and the A49 bypass.
- The possibility of further access being opened onto Foldgate View.
- Overburdening of local services.
- The detrimental impact on the environment and wildlife in the area.
- The site is located outside of the SAMDeV boundary.

The Town Clerk informed members that she had spoken with Mr David Edwards, Flood and Water Manager for Shropshire Council . The report was compiled to comply with EU directives. In the prescribed EU methodology the area was divided into 1 km2 and the recent consultation would create a final document which was based on local priorities and identified Ludlow fourth highest risk in terms of flooding.

Members thanked the Town Clerk for the information and requested that more information come to LTC when available.
