Town Design Plan

Councillor Boddington informed members that Mr Ian Kilby, Development Area Manager Shropshire Council and Councillor Mal Price, Portfolio Holder for Planning, Housing, Regulatory Services and Environment at Shropshire Council had met with him in Ludlow to take a tour of the town centre. They were in agreement that Ludlow would benefit by having a 'Town Design Guide' to advise new occupants on parameters within the Conservation Area with regards to colour schemes, signage, awnings, pavement permits, lighting etc...

The Ludlow Civic Society and the Ludlow Conservation Area Advisory Committee would also be consulted along with Ludlow Town Council to draw together the 'Town Design Plan' over the next twelve months.

Over the last few years there have been changes to properties within the Conservation Area especially retail properties some of these changes are destroying the appearance of the town centre.

Trees at Charlton Rise/Sidney Road

Councillor Boddington has been in contact with Shropshire Housing Association (SHA) regarding the felling of the sycamore tree on the green at Charlton Rise which took place recently. The SHA informed him that there were no plans to build on the area but the SHA are considering bringing future housing development in the area forward. Local Unitary Councillors and residents in the area are greatly concerned for the future of the remaining trees and would like a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) put on the three remaining trees as they are of great public amenity.

There is a diagonal footpath across the green which is currently unregistered but has been used for many years. The area could be protected as a 'Town Green' which is a fairly simple process.

The Chair thanked Councillor Boddington for his comments.

The also stated that Ludlow Town Council should be consulted by Shropshire Council in the early stages of planning applications.

Members agreed that Ludlow Town Council would like to contribute 'The Town Design' information pack with input from Ludlow Conservation Area Advisory Committee (LCAAC), Shropshire Council Conservation Officer and Ludlow Civic Society over the next twelve month period.
