Ludlow Town Council manages Ludlow's Street Trading through their policy. The Fish House will not be permitted to use the street trading pitch unless they do so under the terms of the street trading policy. The street trading pitch consents are issued by Ludlow Town Council and the consent for use of the pitch is chargeable at the current rates as detailed in the policy. There are discounts available for longer term periods of street trading and the Fish House would be entitled to these discounts in the same way as any other street trader.

Ludlow Town Council have received reports of obstructions on the pavement in the vicinity of the Angel in Ludlow from members of the public and therefore object to the issuing of a pavement permit unless there are conditions attached that will clearly delineate the pavement permit area and the minimum area of 1.2m required for DDA access compliance.

Ludlow Town Council would require physical barriers / screening to be put in place by The Angel to delineate the boundary of the pavement permit area. The barriers / screening would be a visual delineation of the area to be used by the premises, and enable the public to clearly see and access the public pathway unimpeded by obstacles previously created by careless placement of chairs or tables.
