From April 2023, community groups in Ludlow will be able to apply for grants of up to £1,000 from Ludlow Town Council. The new grant system will replace the current small and project support grants. The total funding pot will be £10,000. The council's aim is to provide support for voluntary and community organisations in Ludlow. Ludlow Town Council declared its Climate Emergency Resolution in 2019 but the pandemic prevented any major action taking place. A survey was undertaken and based on this it was decided that a robust action plan was needed to achieve carbon neutrality by 2030. The Climate action plan was drawn up and voted on by the Council, based around these 6 core groups:

- Energy Efficiency
- Renewable Energy
- Consumption and Waste
- Adaption and Resilience
- Engaging the Community
