Policy

Process

- Applicants and agents are notified that notices must be displayed in a prominent position on the site and left in place for a period of 21 days.
- Applicants are advised that no decision can be issued unless the site notice has been displayed for the appropriate period.
- Photographic evidence is required to prove that the notice has been displayed. Applicants and agents are informed that the application will not be determined until confirmation has been received that the notice has been displayed on site.
- The 21 days runs from the date of the photographic evidence.

16. CARVELL'S THE ART OF TEA, 13 KING STREET, LUDLOW, SY8 1AQ

To note that due to the deadline falling before the meeting, the pavement licence application for 'An area 13.7m (L) x 0.9m (W). Containing tables and chairs, along one side of Fish Street (the premises side of the wall ONLY), down the length to junction with Pepper Lane' was approved under the delegated authority of the Town Clerk in consultation with the Committee Chairman.

18. FUTURE OF A LONDON PLANE TREE IN CASTLE STREET CAR PARK

The tree is owned by Shropshire Council. It is one of several large, impressive trees in Castle Street car park. Unfortunately, the tree roots are causing severe damage to the car park surface and affecting several parking spaces, the tree's canopy is also very low and poses an issue to parked cars.

Arboricultural Officer's from Shropshire Council's Tree Team are recommending that the tree should be removed due to the disruption being created by the damage tarmac, and replaced with a suitable species, which will be contained in a planting pit to ensure establishment and survival. The extra space required for the planting pit may require the sacrifice of a single parking space.

Arboricultural Officer's from Shropshire Council's Tree Team would like the Town Council's thoughts on the above suggestion.
