- iii) The application has not adequately considered the impact of increased traffic related to the operation of the site on Parrys Road.
- iv) The application indicates that the sulphur dioxide levels are expected t remain with permitted limits, but the concentrations mentioned could create unpleasant smells.
- v) The application has not adequately considered the sites impact of the ground water in relation to the effects / risks of contamination of the three SSSI sites locally.

- v) Galdeford carpark opposite Station Drive Surgery hedge overgrown and forcing people into the road.
- vi) Write to Shropshire Council to ensure there is a TPO on the Walnut tree at St Johns and confirm if there was a TPO / and felling application process for the Sycamore tree (felled) on the corner of Temeside & Old Street.
