The proposal to construct vehicular access (off A49) with a 'Ghost Island' is a commercial decision by developers a roundabout would service future development to the east of the A49 which would have a positive impact in the area and improve safety to the A49 as a traffic calming measure.

To reiterate previous comments made on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2018

The access is unworkable and will detrimentally impact on Ludlow. The proposed entrance off the A49 would involve the removal of 140 mature trees.

The loss of trees would have a noise impact on residents (as the trees act as a sound barrier / filter) and would have a significant negative impact visual amenity of a major route way into Ludlow, and therefore negatively alter the perception of potential visitors to Ludlow.

The proposed plans undermine the initial intention of the A49 sound reduction measures.

Three major supporters of the development (Highways Authority, Railways and Shropshire Trees) have now suspended their support.
