- 2. Community Gain RE: 4.15 Development Brief. LTC would like to propose that Aldi show a willingness to contribute to the wider community of Ludlow by financing a five year programme of strategic publicity for the independent shops, especially those who would have to compete with Aldi, and who are crucial to Ludlow's economy, in terms of local residents and tourism.
- 3. Articulated lorries would appear to have to make potentially hazardous manoeuvres to make deliveries
- 4. The provision of cycle stands is only the minimum amount required for such a development and increased provision might be more useful and realistic.

R20/08 TRANSPORT, PARKING & PATHS

- (a) Closure of Broadgate Arch Representational Committee recommend to Council that Ludlow Town Council reaffirm its opposition to the closure of Broadgate Arch.
- **(b) Street lighting** Cllr Perks' report was deferred.
- (c) Cycle Parking in Ludlow The Representational Committee considered the proposed sites for cycle parking facilities in Ludlow and made the following recommendations:
 - 1. Signage of the cycle stands seems largely unnecessary, and would cause too much visual clutter.
 - 2. Proposed cycle stands along the wall by the war memorial are inappropriately placed because they would interfere with the Remembrance Sunday ceremony.
 - 3. Proposed cycle standing in front of Broadhurst and Deli may create an obstruction
 - 4. Suggestions for alternative/additional sites:
 - * Near the Wheeler Road Skate Park
 - * At the Linney
 - * Near the Youth Club, Lower Galdeford
- (d) Ludlow Cycling Support Group The letter from Co-ordinator, Sally Ford was NOTED.

- **(e) Zebra Crossing** –Shropshire County Council proposed Zebra Crossing on Lower Galdeford was **NOTED**.
- **(f) Gravel Hill Conservation Area** –Shropshire District Council designation of the Gravel Hill / Julian Road / St Julian's Avenue Area of Ludlow as a conservation Area at their meeting on 14th February 2008 was **NOTED**.
- **(g) Parking suspension**–Shropshire County Council application for temporary suspension of parking Arrangements in Upper and Lower Galdeford for three weeks from 21st February 2008 WAS **NOTED**.
- (h) Road Closure Shropshire County Council intension to make an order to temporarily prohibit traffic from proceeding on a section of 50m of Station Drive, from its junction with Gravel Hill on 2 March 2008 for one day was NOTED.

- (j) Carriageway Works –Shropshire County Council contractors will undertake minor drainage and kerbing works at Station Drive / Gravel Hill and Upper and Lower Galdeford commencing on 18th February 2008 for a period of three weeks was NOTED.
