	Climate and Health Impacts Car engines are a major cause of both noise and air pollution. Leaving them idling simply exacerbates this problem. Air pollution is now the single greatest environmental risk to human health, causing increased levels of cancer, heart disease and other cardiovascular illness. Car engines emit, when idling, high levels of NO2 and fine particulates, which the government's Clean Air Strategy (2019) aims to reduce.
