R/142 GRANTS, PLANNING, TRANSPORT, PARKING & PATHS

(a) DISABLED PARKING BAYS

RESOLVED (unanimous)
SMc / GP

That members support provision to make disabled parking bay restrictions enforceable in principle, but would like to receive more information regarding other possible sites before suggesting any course of action

Members would like to invite an appropriate Shropshire Council Traffic Officer to write a letter to make the residents aware that the bays are not for the specific use of any one resident and if the current situation continues, the Town Council is considering making a request to change the status of the bay, which may result in parking enforcement in the area.

(b) VEHICLE ACTIVATED SIGNS (VAS)

RESOLVED (unanimous) JS/PT GP

(i) That the second Vehicle Activated Signs is put into the current rota so that two sites have VAS at any one time and members would like to identify other areas of Ludlow that may be included in the rota.

The highest priority is Parry's Road. Other areas of concern are Bromfield Road near to Burway Lane; Temeside Road; Henley Road (traffic travelling out of Ludlow; and Foldgate lane, which is used as a 'rat run'.

(ii) To use the BB newsletter and website to seek the opinions of residents to identify speeding problem areas in Ludlow.

RECOMMEND (unanimous) JS / PT

That Ludlow Town Council purchases a VAS sign for one of the areas that experience traffic speeding problems in Ludlow

Members would like the Town Council to work with Shropshire Council and the Police to encourage residents to engage I road safety monitoring such as using radar guns to monitor the speed of cars in problem areas.

(c) WAITING RESTRICTION ON SANDPITS ROAD

RESOLVED (unanimous)

- (I) To support the revised sketch diagram from Shropshire Council and ask for a further yellow line to prevent parking on the blind bend on the section of Sandpits Road from the junction of Whitefriars towards Henley Road (as indicated in Appendix 1)
- (ii) To write to the school and Hendra House to inform them of the committee's decision.

(d) PARKING CONSULTATION

- (i) Members noted the consultation and asked Shropshire Council to provide the running costs and revenue generated by each car parks in Ludlow
- (ii) To find out from Shropshire Council if market trader permits are valid to use on a Sunday
