
LUDLOW MEDIEVAL CHRISTMAS FAYRE

ENTRY TO LUDLOW MEDIEVAL CHRISTMAS FAURE ON SUNDAY 24TH NOVEMBER



Welcome from the Mayor, **Councillor Tim Gill**

Since September, Ludlow Town Council has been considering the 2020/21 budget. In October, the Government announced that there will be no 'referendum principles' for town and parish councils in 2020/21.



The 4% cap of Shropshire Council's 2019/20 precept of over £154 million raises in excess of £6 million; but a 4% cap of Ludlow Town Councils half a million precept (£557, 037) raises just over £22,000 - and a higher rise would cost the tax payer up to £14,000. Ludlow Town Council is committed to providing funding for one-off projects to improve infrastructure. Clearly, such a decision could severely limit the effectiveness of the Town Council.


The Town Council has been hoping for financial help from Central Government, but the Non-Domestic Rating Public Lavatories Bill fell through due to the recent prorogation of Parliament. It would have removed business rates for buildings with public toilets, effectively making the facilities cheaper to run, and Ludlow Town Council would have saved at least £4.578 a year, but we now has to continue to pay the rates to keep Castle Street, Smithfield and the Linney public toilets open. Budget Setting

Ludlow Town Council are currently setting the budget for financial year 2020/21.

The Town Council's plan since 2017 has been to grow its financial reserves to enable us to undertake a number of projects and create financial capacity to assist Ludlow in areas that Shropshire Council are reducing funding for youth services, tourism and transport. Annually Ludlow Town Council's budget delivers a range of local services. Some services also generate an income.


