### SERVICE FOR COMMEMORATION OF WW1 SUNDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> AUGUST 2014

On Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2014 a service was held at St Laurence's Church to commemorate the commencement of WW1. The Mayor and Councillors, along with visiting Mayors processed to the Church. Local uniformed organisations also paraded into Church accompanied by the Town Band. Wreaths were then layed at the War Memorial and young people read the names of the 138 service personnel from Ludlow.

On Monday 4<sup>th</sup> August a candlelit vigil held at St Laurence's to reflect the national request for darkness lit by candles.


