- **FC01/09 APOLOGIES** There were no apologies for absence.
- **FC02/09 PREJUDICIAL AND PERSONAL INTERESTS** There were no declarations of interest made.
- **FC03/09 ADDRESS FROM TOWN MAYOR** Councillor Newbold addressed the meeting. His Mayoral Charity for the past year was Age Concern and he presented a cheque to Heather Osbourne, Chief Executive of Age Concern, for the amount of £1,924.43.
- **FC04/09 ELECTION OF TOWN MAYOR** Councillor Pope proposed, Councillor Glaze seconded and it was **RESOLVED** that Councillor Taylor-Smith be elected Town Mayor of Ludlow for the Municipal Year 2009/10.
- **FC05/09 DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE** The Declaration of Acceptance of Office was signed by the Mayor, Councillor Taylor-Smith, and he addressed the meeting.

- **FC07/09 DECLARATION OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFICE** The Declaration of Acceptance of Office was signed by the Deputy Mayor, Councillor Davies.
- FC08/09 ANNOUNCEMENT OF MAYORESS/CONSORT The Town Mayor announced that Rosanna Taylor-Smith would be his Mayoress for 2009/10.
- FC09/09 APPOINTMENT OF MAYOR'S CHAPLAIN The Town Mayor announced that Revd Preb Brian Curnew, Rector of Ludlow, would be his Chaplain for 2009/10.



- FC10/09 APPOINTMENT OF COMMON SERGEANT & MACE-BEARER The Town Mayor appointed Graham Davies as the Common Sergeant and John Coxill as the Mace-Bearer for 2008/09.
- **FC11/09 MAYOR'S ALLOWANCE** It was **RESOLVED** to approve the Town Mayor's Allowance of £3,280 for 2009/10. The Mayor reported that there had been no increase from last year.
- **FC12/09 CIVIC AWARDS** The Town Mayor presented a Civic Award to Police Constable Tony Sewell.
- FC13/09 ANNUAL TOWN RESIDENTS MEETING It was NOTED that the Annual Town Residents Meeting was scheduled for Friday 29th May 2009 at 8.00pm in Oscars, Ludlow Assembly Rooms, and the Town Mayor invited all to attend.
