GUIDANCE NOTES FOR STONEMASONS

NO STONE MAY BE ERECTED UNTIL PERMISSION HAS BEEN GRANTED. NOTICE OF THE DATE OF FIXING MUST BE GIVEN TO THE CEMETERY OFFICER.

Disturbed earth must be left for six months before a headstone can be installed. When the headstone is installed the ground must be levelled.

No chains or fences are permitted. No kerbstones are permitted.

Headstones:

must be fixed below ground level to either a plinth of:

a) wet concrete 3 inches thick and 3 inches wider than the Headstone x 2ft 6 for a 3ft high Headstone; or b) a concrete slab 3 ft x 2ft x 2 inches

Sections must be joined by steel dowels.

The Council requires the Plot / Row / Grave Number to be visibly inscribed on every stone.

Vertical headstones must have the inscription engraved on the back of the stone.

Cremation Area:

Care should be taken to align all memorials with previous stones and rows.

Cremation plot stones must be a standard size - 18inches x 18 inches and can be flat or sloping.

Upright stones are also permitted but they must not exceed 18 inches in height with a base not exceeding 16 inches wide or long.

Stones must be laid with a gap of 1 ft between stones and 2 ft between rows.

Stones must also be set on a slab of concrete 2 inches wider than the stone.

The Council requires the Plot / Row / Grave Number to be visibly inscribed on every stone.

Horizontal stones must have the inscription engraved on the edge of the stone.

Ludlow Cemetery:

At the time of fixing the headstone the Mason should level the grave either by removing a mound or by filling a hollow.

All waste material and stones must be removed from the site to the waste disposal area.

Due to damage to paths, vehicles other than hearses are not permitted beyond the Car Park.

All regulations are to assist with the maintenance of the Cemetery and for the benefit of all who use the cemetery your co-operation is appreciated.
