#### 09/02758/FUL - LTC comments:

- 1. The garage appears to be too dominant and detracts from the existing street scene
- 2. The dwelling seems out of keeping with the existing street scene and detrimental to the general amenity of the neighbouring houses.
- 3. Moving the house backwards on the site would improve the overall symmetry of the street scene
- 4. Moving the position of the house further back on the plot would reduce the future flood risk.
- 5. It appears that only one neighbour has been consulted, which suggests a lack of effective consultation.
- 6. Cllrs noted that no planning advice had been sought prior to the application.

## R241/08/09 PLANNING, TRANSPORT, PARKING & PATHS

#### (a) Urban Speed Limit Policy & Rural Roads Speed Limit Policy

Cllrs made the following comments:

### **RE: Urban Speed Limit Policy**

- (i) Cllrs welcomed the clearly laid out table identifying the speed limit and the situations where it would be warranted.
- (ii) Cllrs suggested that the area by Ludlow Hospital should be designated a 20mph zone
- (iii) Sheet Road should be 30mph, and clearly signed, from the A49 roundabout.
- (iv) The maximum speed limit for the whole of Ludlow should be 30mph.
- (v) Uniformity of speed limit within a short distance should be encourages i.e. areas were speed limit changes from 20mph to 30mph and then back to 20mph in less that half a mile should be discouraged.
- (vi) Lower urban speed limits would be one way of encouraging other modes of transport such as cycling, walking and buses.
- (vii) Ludlow Town Council supports Ludlow Cycling Support Group manifesto, which advocates a 20mph speed limit for the safety and encouragement of cycling, especially for children.
- (viii) Digital responsive slow-down (or driver speed indicator) signs are a very useful tool, which is successfully used in some areas of Ludlow, but could be more widely used.
- (ix) Cllrs asked if low speed limits were enforceable can the current speed guns be calibrated to accurately detect slow speeds?
- (x) Capital programme: Cllrs asked how the funds for market towns would be allocated?

#### **RE: Rural Roads Speed Limit Policy**

- (i) Cllrs were impressed by the clarity of the priorities expressed in Appendix A
- (ii) Cllrs welcomed the use of repeater speed signs to reinforce limits

# (b) Cittaslow Ludlow Questionnaire Clirs considered the questionnaire and made the following comments:

In general terms, Cllrs approved of the questionnaire and awaited the answers and analysis with interest.

Member agreed that a secure business plan was needed to be provided to support the activities of the group.

Cllrs did express concerns that Q1 seemed to indicate that this imitative could be 'another organisation with a building and rooms to let' Cllr agreed that there were plenty of such opportunities already available in Ludlow and asked if property would be the best use of the funds.

Cllrs are supportive of making 'help with funding applications available to organisation and especially because the trust would have 'unique' streams of funding available.

- **(c) Road Closure** –The order to temporarily prohibit traffic from proceeding on Henley Road Ludlow on the section between junctions with Gravel Hill , New Road, Dodmore Lane and Sandpits Road on 23<sup>rd</sup> October for two weeks was **NOTED.**
- **(d) Road Closure -** T he order to temporarily prohibit traffic from proceeding on Lower Galdeford from Upper Galdeford and Friars Garden on 9<sup>th</sup> November for seven days was **NOTED**.
