## R/53 PUBLIC OPEN SESSION (15 minutes)

Four members of the public were present.

Alan Poulton, Chair of the Teme Weirs Trust

<u>Application 13/02973/FUL – Installation of Hydraulic fish pass, Dinham Weir,</u> <u>Ludlow</u>

Mr Poulton said that he was aware that the planning application had been withdrawn as it had been granted a Certificate of Lawfulness. He wished to object to this as he felt in his opinion that it would impact on the flow of water and change the nature of the river. He also asked that after the installation of the hydraulic fish pass, who would be inspecting it to ensure that it had been correctly installed?

He continued by saying that considerable work had been carried out on the Weir ten years ago to help the salmon spawn and the application from the Green Café to install seating platforms for fishermen down stream, as in his opinion he was sure that they would be affected as a result of the fish pass.

Mr Poulton also advised the Committee that the horseshoe weir needed repair but that he had been told that he required the permission from the Environment Agency and this has been refused.

He asked what constituted permitted development and urged the Committee to obtain any studies that had been carried out by Fishtek on hydrological water rates. He added that once a licence had been issued to allow water to be taken out of a river this would continue for years and would have an impact on the river water flow, rate and environment.

Councillor Rosanna Taylor-Smith informed the Committee that the Planning Officer, Dyanne Humphreys would no longer be attending the Representational Committee meetings of the Town Council. She said that she had sent a note of thanks to the Planning Officer thanking her for her input which she was certain had been of benefit to the Town Council. She added that she was unable to comment on the applications, as she was a member of Shropshire Council's Planning Committee but if there were questions she would refer them to a Planning Officer who would report back to the Town Council.

She went on to say that many of the applications on the Town Council's Agenda for this evening had been discussed at the Local Conservation Area Advisory Committee. Councillor Rosanna Taylor-Smith highlighted that application 13/02903/OUT had been withdrawn and this was the re-submission and informed the Committee that work was due to start on the Weir on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013. Regarding application 13/03227/TEL she informed the Committee that this was the installation of a broadband box on Tower Street and she said she along with residents and businesses welcomed any improvement on broadband provision.
