R17/08/09 PLANNING, TRANSPORT, PARKING & PATHS

(a) **Town & Country Planning Act 190** – Members deferred the selection a representative to attend the appeal relating to the application listed below, at 10am on 5th August at Council offices Stone House, until the next Representational meeting on 15th July 2008.

Alteration to boundary wall to remove gate and provide double doors to facilitate a vehicular access
33 Broad Street
LTC comments: Subject to the views of the Conservation Officer
SSDC comments: The proposed aperture is considered to be incongruous within the street scene and is discordant with the order and rhythm created by the surrounding architecture.

(b) **Shropshire County Council** –Shropshire County Council order prohibiting the use of part of the Footpath 21, Ludlow, which runs from the riverside in an easterly direction between Dinham Millennium Green and the Old Mill building off the Linney, until 21 January 2009 due to delays in beginning construction work at the Mill on the Green and on grounds of public safety was **NOTED**.

(c) **Shropshire County Council** – Shropshire County Council order to temporarily prohibit traffic from proceeding on a 30m section of Footway on Bell Lane, Ludlow from 9 June for six weeks was **NOTED**.

(d) **Road Closure** –Ludlow Marches Festival of Food & Drink application for a road closure on King Street, High Street & Castle Street, Ludlow was **NOTED**. Ludlow Town Council **AGREED** to send a letter to SCC supporting the road closure for the festival.

(e) **Proposed Withdrawal of Public Pay Phones** – Members felt that BT’s proposal in relation to phone boxes within Ludlow and surrounding area provided insufficient information for them to reach any meaningful decision.
