Bull Hotel Gate:

1. Whilst Mr Buteux acknowledged the need for some form of barrier, he was concerned that a more permanent door would lead to more permanent closure – current closure (Festival/Fri & Sat nights) already more frequent than officially stated (festival only)

Mr Buteux was concerned that the Bull was being turned into a night club through a series a seemingly small changes (including making use of internal space previously used for B&B accommodation) that would, in the end, result in a noisy night club causing an unacceptable level of disturbance in a residential area.

Mr Buteux was already aware of incidents of abusive language and loud and unpleasant behaviour, which had effected visitors staying at the Feathers Hotel.

Bull Hotel Gate:

1. Creates a cul-de-sac on the church walk side – The dark space caused

behind the door could be a potentially menacing hiding space, or somewhere that might encourage small groups to congregate.

In this case, the business interests of the Bull, which are focused on a narrow based cliental, predominantly the younger age group, seem to out weigh the interests of the wider community.
