## R177/08/09 PLANNING, TRANSPORT, PARKING & PATHS

a) Parking and Highways – Within Cllrs consideration of Parking and Highways Sub-Committee, there is the aim to be as inclusive as possible with a wide cross section of the population of Ludlow. With this aim in mind, Cllrs considered a letter received from Ludlow Civic Society requesting closer involvement with the Town Council on Conservation planning matters. Cllrs agreed that the Civic society such receive a copy of all agenda and minutes from Representational meetings and of course attend and speak in the public session regarding any applications that were of concern to them. Cllrs also agreed that it would be possible, in certain circumstances, to suspend standing orders to allow discussion to take place.

Cllrs decide to make the following recommendations regarding Highways & Parking Advisory Committee:

- i. It become a sub-committee of, and reports back to, Representational Committee
- ii. Membership would include outside bodies representing a wide cross section of Ludlow. Each invited group would have one identified voting member, although up to three members per group would be able to attend.
- iii. Town Councillor membership should be limited to three. It was expected that membership would be from Representation Committee, although not necessarily exclusively.
- iv. Meetings would take place on a 'as need arises' basis
- v. Existing terms of reference would be adopted and/or amended for ratification
