**For all other road closures:** Shropshire Council have advised that all the works listed above have been assessed on an individual basis and road closure is the only viable option due to not being able to maintain an absolute minimum width for traffic to pass safely. Shropshire Council have stated that they work to minimise disruption, and only use road closures when all other options are explored and found not to be viable, as it is recognised that road closures can be disruptive.
